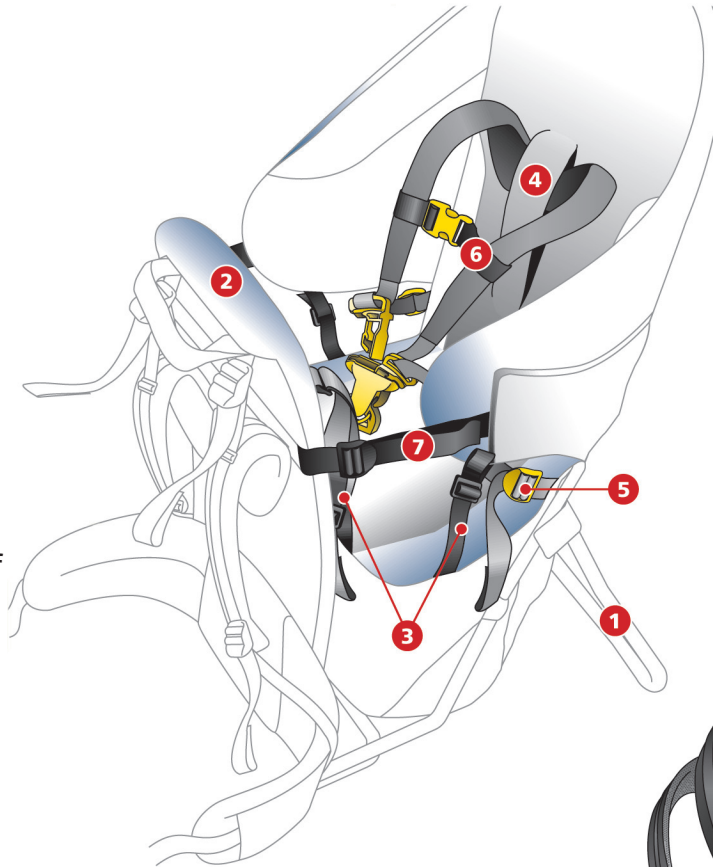




Kid Comfort User Manual

All the Kid Comfort child carriers are TÜV approved and carry the GS safety certificate. The TÜV is an independent testing facility in Germany that ensures the safety of products at both the production and finished good level. Their tests push wear and tear on the product to the limit to ensure a high quality and safe product is on the market.

- 1 The stand should always be used when the child is being placed in or taken out of the carrier. The child should never be left unattended in carrier.
- 2 The height of seat is ideal when the child can see out and move his or her arms freely. Their chin should be level with the chin pad.
- 3 The strap in front of the child as well as the ones on the sides of seat act to raise and lower the seat depending on the size of the child.
- 4 The child harness can be moved up and down with the Velcro® attachment point. The harness should be snug at all times.



- 5 All the YELLOW buckles should be fastened to ensure the child's safety. It is recommended that all these buckles remain fastened snugly, so the child cannot move themselves out of the seat.
- 6 Position the sternum strap in the middle of the child's chest and fasten the buckle.
- 7 Tighten the side compression straps in order to move child closer to the frame and thus more in-line with the parent's center of gravity.
- 8 The Vari Quick diagram illustrates how to adjust the harness system for the adult. The Velcro® attachment can be undone and moved up and down the ladder adjustment system. The strap on harness needs to slide under 4 bars on the ladder system to be properly fastened.
