2. Safety Instructions

- 1. **Use appropriate tools:** Ensure you have all the necessary tools at hand and that they are in good condition before starting the repair.

3. Additional Safety Instructions for Burning Fabric Edges

- 1. **Caution when handling fire:** Working with a lighter involves risks. Make sure to work in a well-ventilated and safe area, away from flammable materials and liquids.
- 2. **Remove flammable materials:** Keep all flammable materials, such as fabrics, papers, or chemicals, at least one meter away from the work area to minimize the risk of fire.
- 3. **Work in well-ventilated areas:** Perform edge-burning of fabrics only outdoors or in well-ventilated spaces, as heating can produce unpleasant or harmful fumes.
- 4. **Use appropriate lighters:** Use a reliable lighter suitable for the intended purpose. Ensure it is in good condition and free from leaks.
- 5. **Keep moving:** Keep the lighter in motion and do not hold it in one spot for too long to avoid overheating or burning the material.
- 6. **Stay attentive:** Never leave the lighter unattended while it is lit, and avoid distractions during the process.
- 7. **First aid measures:** Keep a first aid kit nearby in case of injuries or burns. Review the steps to take in the event of a fire or injury.
